

CENTRAL TABLELANDS WATER (CTW) LEVEL 1 WATER RESTRICTIONS

CTW advises its consumers that Level 1 water restrictions will come into effect from Monday 3 August 2020.

Residential – Watering of lawns	Watering systems, microsprays, drip systems, soaker hoses, non-fixed sprinklers, handheld hoses only.	Between 6am to 10am daily AEST)* and Between 4pm to 10pm daily (AEST)*
Watering of Residential Gardens	Watering systems, microsprays, drip systems, soaker hoses, non-fixed sprinklers, handheld hoses only.	Between 6am to 10am daily AEST)* and Between 4pm to 10pm daily (AEST)*
Residential – Irrigation of New Turf	Permitted for one week after laying after which level 1 restriction on watering lawns applies.	
Washing down walls or paved surfaces	Not permitted.	Not permitted.
Topping up private swimming pools/spas	Permitted.	Permitted.
First fill of private swimming pools	Permitted.	Permitted.
Washing cars at home	Permitted with a bucket and rinse with trigger hose on lawn at any time.	Permitted.
